FROM I-75 (coming from Richmond/ Berea, etc.)

- Take the KY-418 exit, EXIT 104,
- toward Lexington/Athens. Turn left onto Athens Boonesboro Rd/KY-418 W.If you reach I-75 N you've gone about 0.3 miles
- too far go 2.6 mi Athens Boonesboro Rd/KY-418 W becomes Richmond Rd/US-25N/ US-421 N. - go 1.6 mi
- Turn left onto Man O' War Blvd. go 1.0 mi
- Take the 3rd right onto
- Alumni Dr. go .7 mi Turn left to take the KY-4 S ramp. go .2 mi
- Merge onto New Circle Rd/KY-4 W. - go 2.8 mi
- Take the US-27/Nicholasville Rd exit, EXIT 19, toward Nicholasville/ Lexington. – go .3 mi Turn left onto Nicholasville Rd/
- US-27. go .5 mi
- Turn right onto W Reynolds Rd. –
- 483W REYNOLDS RD is on the right about .1 mi past Ruccio Wy.

FROM I-75 (coming from Cincinnati, Georgetown, Frankfort etc.)

- Take the KY-922/Newtown Pike exit, EXIT 115, toward Martha Layne Collins Bluegrass Parkway/Airport/Lexington. go .3 mi
- Merge onto Newtown Pike/KY-922 S toward Lexington Airport/Martha Layne Collins Bluegrass Parkway. – go 1.6 mi
- Merge onto W New Circle Rd/KY-4 W toward Martha Layne Collins Bluegrass Parkway/Airport. go 9.2 mi
- Take the Nicholasville Rd/US-27 exit, EXIT 19, toward Lexington/ Nicholasville. - go .3 mi
- Turn right onto Nicholasville Rd/ US-27. - go .3 mi
- Turn right onto W Reynolds Rd. go .6 mi
- 483 W REYNOLDS RD is on the right about .1 mi past Ruccio Way.

FROM Nicholasville & South Lexington

- Traveling on U.S. 27, take a left onto West Reynolds Road
- Turn left onto W Reynolds Rd. go .6 mi
- 483 W REYNOLDS RD is on the right about .1 mi past Ruccio Wy.

FROM Eastern Kentucky

- Merge onto I-75 S via EXIT 81 on the left toward Richmond/ Knoxville. - go 1.5 mi
- Take the US-60 exit, EXIT 110, toward Lexington. - go .3 mi
- Turn right onto Winchester Rd/ US-60. - go 1.8 mi
- Merge onto E New Circle Rd/ KY-4 S via the ramp on the left. - go 6.4 mi
- Take the US-27/Nicholasville Rd exit, EXIT 19, toward Nicholasville/Lexington. go .3 mi
- Turn left onto Nicholasville Rd/ US-27. - go .5 mi
- Turn right onto W Reynolds Rd. – go .6 mi
- 483 W REYNOLDS RD is on the right about .1 mi past Ruccio Way.
